

Casa Grande Main Street Doors to the Past Project Request for Artists

Project Information:

Casa Grande Main Street is seeking new artwork from local artists in order to create "new" Doors to the Past. The Doors to the Past is a staple historic preservation project located in Historic Downtown Casa Grande on the north-east corner of 3rd Street and Florence Street. Completed in 2013, each of the nine (9) doors represents a piece of Casa Grande's history as interpreted by a local artist. Due to ten (10) years of Arizona weather, these current Doors to the Past are cracking and falling apart. This program is designed to incorporate a wide variety of artists and new interpretations of Casa Grande's history into the Historic Downtown Casa Grande district. Artists will be provided the doors which to complete their designs on, as well as a \$550 payment to cover the cost of supplies and labor.





Specifications:

- Successful proposals will foster community pride and convey a person, place, or idea that is an important part of Casa Grande's history.
- There are no specific topics for the Doors. However, when designing the artwork artists should
 research their desired topic and ensure that its historical significance is something that should
 be publically displayed and boasted in our Historic Downtown. Artwork must be in good taste.
 Artists are encouraged to visit the Museum of Casa Grande to gain inspiration or learn more on
 their desired topic. Artists should email info@tmocg.org for Museum and archive information.
- Casa Grande Main Street has five (5) Doors that must be re-done by members of the community. All proposals will be reviewed by Casa Grande Main Street's Doors to the Past Committee, and the top five (5) will be selected.
- Doors will provided by Casa Grande Main Street to the five (5) artists/groups whose proposals have been selected.



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 Selected artists will be provided with \$550 to cover the cost of supplies and labor. \$275 will be given at the start of the project, and the remaining \$275 given once the artwork/project is completed.

Criteria for Design and Painting of Artwork

- Designs are for the front of the door, and all 4 sides. The back of the door will not be visible to the community.
- Designs must reflect a historical aspect from Casa Grande's history. Feel free to visit the current Doors to the Past to understand what sort of historical ideas are being requested. Artists are encouraged to visit the Museum of Casa Grande to get inspiration.
- No offensive designs, or designs that contain advertising, sexual or illegal drug content, negative imagery, or convey political messaging.
- Designs may not include any breach of intellectual property, copyrights, trademarks, brands, images of illegal activity or involve the attachment of any objects to the door.

Materials to be Used:

Acrylic Type Paints

Submittals:

- Open to Pinal County residents and organizations
- Artist proposals must include the following:
 - Design idea
 - Design draft made to scale. Doors are 36in x 80in, and design drafts can be submitted on papers sized: 8x11, 10x14, or 11x17.
 - Written description of why this historical aspect is significant/why it should be represented
 - List of what materials will be used, and cost estimate.
- Selected artists will be required to sign a public art agreement, and will be held subject to all requirements, deadlines, and restrictions.

Schedule:

- There is currently no set schedule for this project, as it will remain open until all remaining
 Doors have been completed. Applications will be reviewed as Casa Grande Main Street
 receives them. Artists will be notified—either confirmed or denied—within two weeks after
 Main Street has received their application.
- Artists are expected to have their Door completed within three months of receiving their canvass (door) and payment.
- Completed Doors will be hung up as they are finished.
