**Casa Grande, AZ** – COVID-19 has shifted and changed many aspects of our community—and Casa Grande Main Street is no exception to this. Therefore, due to the current City and State restrictions and guidelines in place to slow the spread of COVID-19, Casa Grande Main Street is unable to obtain the permits necessary in order to host the 21<sup>st</sup> Annual Street Fair in January, 2021. Though our City continues to show improvements in our COVID-19 related numbers, we must follow the CDC, State, and local guidelines established in order to keep our community safe.

It is our hope that our strong, resilient community will stay safe and healthy, as to get our numbers where needed, so that we may obtain the necessary permits to host the 21<sup>st</sup> Annual Street Fair in March, 2021. Casa Grande Main Street has, for many years, hosted the Fine Art Explosion on the second weekend of March. Provided that Casa Grande continues to have fewer cases of COVID-19, Main Street plans to combine the 21<sup>st</sup> Annual Street Fair and the Fine Art Explosion into one, large, amazing event for our community.

Although we understand that this decision may not be accepted with ease, we hope that it is understood that our decision to push back the Annual Street Fair was not an easy one to make. However, our love for this community, and our desire to see it thrive, had to take priority.
